If required, VLA may pay for an interpreter when using our legal information and advice services. Ask for one to be booked when making an appointment.

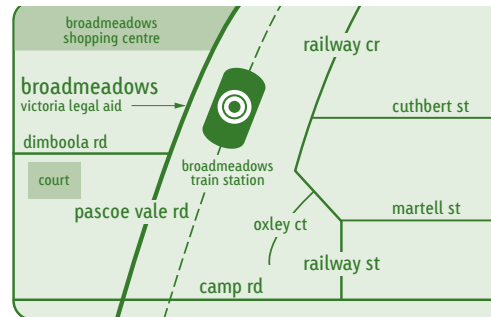

: VICTORIA LEGAL AID (VLA)

The legal advice that we may help you with is:

- criminal law
- family breakdown
- family violence
- civil law matters

Our offices, situated in 14 locations throughout Victoria, are open Monday to Friday, 8.45am – 5.15pm.

: BROADMEADOWS

The North Western suburbs regional office (situated at Broadmeadows) provides to the community a range of free services. These are:

Advice services (by appointment):

- legal advice – Monday – Friday
- family law
- Children's Court (criminal matters) – Tuesday afternoons
- child support – first Thursday of the month.

Telephone advice – urgent matters only.

Advice services (without appointment):

- crime, family and civil – Wednesdays 1.30pm – 4.00pm.

Duty lawyer services:

Criminal charges and traffic offences:

- Broadmeadows Magistrates' Court – every day
- Broadmeadows Children's Court – Tuesday
- Seymour Magistrates' Court – every second Thursday
- Koori Court – every second Tuesday

Family violence:

- Broadmeadows Magistrates' Court – Friday

It is important to get legal advice before you go to court. Contact the Broadmeadows office on 9302 8777 to make an appointment or for more information.

: IT IS IMPORTANT TO GET LEGAL ADVICE BEFORE YOU GO TO COURT

: LEGAL ADVICE

For legal advice with a VLA lawyer, an appointment is usually necessary. If you are not able to keep the appointment please give us 24 hours notice.

Please bring to your appointment the following:

- all paperwork
- taped record of interview with police
- pay slips and/or Health Care Card
- bank statements.

: GRANTS OF LEGAL ASSISTANCE

VLA provides legal assistance for a lawyer to represent you in court in some areas of law. There are guidelines outlining the areas where grants of legal assistance are made.

If you require legal assistance you can ask one of our lawyers or a private lawyer to help you apply. This can be discussed at your appointment. Application forms for legal assistance can be obtained from all VLA offices. If you need an interpreter VLA will pay somebody to help you fill in the form.

: COSTS

It costs nothing to apply for legal assistance. However, legal assistance is not always free. You may have to pay some or all of your legal costs. The amount you will be asked to pay will depend on your financial position.

If VLA offers you legal assistance, a letter will be sent to you setting out the conditions. You should read the letter carefully and if you do not understand it contact us.

More detailed information is provided in the VLA Grant of legal assistance and application form.

: CONFIDENTIALITY

VLA treats any information you give us as strictly confidential, unless the law states otherwise. If VLA owes a duty of confidentiality to anyone else who might be involved in your matter, we may only be able to provide you with general information and referral. A duty of confidentiality may apply if we have ever provided the other person with assistance about a current or past matter.

: HELP AT COURT

It is important that you get legal advice before you go to court.

If you do not have a lawyer when you go to court, duty lawyers who give free legal advice and other help may be available at court and tribunal hearings. Duty lawyers can represent you in court. However, they must give priority to serious cases and people in custody, which means there are times when they cannot help everyone.

Ask the staff at the court or tribunal if a duty lawyer is available.
