## PRIVACY PRINCIPLES

The Privacy and Data Protection Act 2014 has 10 privacy principles for handling personal information.

## 10. Sensitive information –

e.g. ethnic background or criminal record – is protected. Check the rules first. 1. Only collect what you really **need**.

2. Use and disclose information for the purpose you got it.

9. Take care when sending information outside Victoria.

3. Ensure the information is accurate.

8. Let people be anonymous whenever possible.

4. Keep it secure.

7. Only create "unique identifiers" when allowed.

5. Be open about what we do with personal information. Tell people about our privacy policy.

6. Let the person see it and correct it if it's wrong.
